Sudbury. 6th of May 1793...

At a Legal Town Meeting held in Sudbury on the day & Year Above. & proceeded to the business of 1st day - and Voted, to send a Representative, to the General Court, the year En-
suing, - & then chose William Rice Esq^r. a freeholder, & President, in 1st town, to serve for, & Represent 1st town, in General Court the Year Ensuing.

2^d Article, Chose Col^l. Jon^a. Rice Moderator - Then proceed-
ed, to the Consideration of the 9th Art^{le} as contained in
in this 2^d article, - after a considerable debate, upon the
Subject matter, of this Art^{le}. The Question was put, To see,
if the town, would Direct, their Representative, to assist
Capt. Bowker, Respecting 1st Art^{le} and passed in the Neg-
ative, -

3^d Art^{le} then voted to Discharge, M^r. James Thompson, the
Sum he stands charg^d with, as set forth in 1st Art^{le}, -

4th Art^{le} passed over. -

5th Then voted, ~~to direct~~ that Doctor Tafts, should deliver up a
Quint, Signed by Col^l. Jon^a. Rice, - as Express in 1st art^{le}

6th Art^{le} Voted, to choose a Committee, for the purpose Express,
In this Art^{le} - 1st Com^{tee}, to consist of five, - & the select-
men, were appointed, for 1st Com^{tee} - and Report at the
next Town Meeting. -

These are to Notify, & warn, all the freeholders, & other Inhabi-
tants, of the town of Sudbury, Qualified as the Law Directs, to vote,
In Town affair, to Meet, at the Meeting house, in 1st town, on
Monday, the seventh day of October Next, at 1. o'Clock afternoon,
on 1st day, then and there, -

1st To Choose a Moderator, & bring in Town Debts, & Credit. -

2^d To see, if the town will Grant, to their Road Minister, his Salu-
ry, the year Ensuing, Do or Not, any other way, in this article,
as the town, shall think proper, when Met.

3^d To see, if the town, will Grant Money, for the support, of a
Grammar School, the year Ensuing, and order where the
same shall be kept, Do or not &c. -
