8th Article, Then voted, To reconsider ~~the~~ Grant of £17. made for the purpose & put in this article, & voted To appropriate, the sum of Seventeen pounds out of Securities, against Individuals, Now in the Treasury, for the purpose of paying the Demand, as Express'd in this Article. — & Ordered this Treas^r to Raise the aforesaid sum within two Months at the furtherance.

11th Then voted, to permit, as on Goodenow, to take the Oath of Collector, ^{of Taxes only.} in stead of Constable, — and Chose Capt. Sam^l Knight Constable for the town. At. Capt. Sam^l Knight has since been sworn to the Office of Constable by the Clerk of the town,

12th Allowed to M^r. William Brown for Repairing the Schoolhouse in the South W. District. To four hundred of Brick & Load of Clay 8/6 to Carting the same 1/6 Twelve Squares of Lath 3/6 to 1 1/2 day of Mason 6/6 to 1 1/2 Day finding Mason 4/6 to 1 day work with a Carpenter 3/6 to three pound putty 1/6 to half a day putting in the Glass 1/6 — 1. 9. 6

To Lt David How for Repairing the School House in the S W. District. for Glass, Boards, Nails, hinges, Spikes, Carpenter & his Labour. £1. 3. 4. — 1. 3. 4

To Lt Asher Cutler for finding the wid^{ow} Hayden with grain in the year 1777. 3 Bushels of Rice & 3 of Indian £1. 19. 0 — 1. 19. 0

13th Granted the sum of £4. 12. 9. for the payment of some Outstanding Orders — 4. 12. 9

Allowed To the widow Elizabeth How for house rent for six of John Shirk's children, while under the Operation of the small Pox £2. 2. 0. Then voted, that Capt. Levi Holden should pay this Grant of £2. 2. 0. shillings to the person afores^d (agreeable to his proposal) & be discharged the same sum, upon some Securities, Now in the Treasury, against him, Then voted, that the S^r Shirk, Give his Obligation, to the town Treas^r. (agreeable to his proposal) for one pound four shillings, in part of the above grant.
