

November Anno Domini 1793

Sudbury November 15th 1793

At a Legal Town Meeting, held in Sudbury on the day & year above^d - proceeded to the business of said day & there bapt. Joseph Goodenew. Moderator -

1st Article, voted to choose a constable in the South Ward. - & M^r. Micah parmenter, was by vote, chosen; - then the Town at said parmenter's Request, Excused him. Serving as constable, and voted, S^d parmenter, be collector of Taxes only. Then the Town, by their vote, accepted Levi parmenter as a collector of Taxes, in the stead, of Micah parmenter. - He the S^d Micah, giving Bonds to Indemnify the Town. - said parmenter has ^{since} taken the oath of office, before the Clerk of S^d Town.

Then the Town, by their vote Dissolved this Meeting. -

- These are to notify, and warn, all the Freeholders, & other Inhabitants, of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified, as the Laws Direct, to vote, in Town affairs, to Meet, at the Meeting House, in S^d Town, on Thursday the 12th Day of Decem^r. Next, at 1 o'clock afternoon, on S^d day then & there -
- 1st To Choose a Moderator. - and See, if the Town, will build a New Meeting House, in S^d town, for their better Convenience. - Do or act, as the Town shall think proper when Met.
 - 2^d To See, if the Town, will Erect, S^d House, as Near the Spot on which the present Meeting House, now stands, as the Majority of S^d town, shall think best, for their accommodation. - Do or act. &c.
 - 3^d To See, if the Town, will Choose a Committee, for Draughting a Plan of said house: - and Report the Cheapest, and most Expeditions Method, of Building said House. Do or act &c.
