Sudbury December 12th 1793 - this Notification has been posted up, at the Desire of the Selectmen, & agreeable to a former vote, of the Town, by Reuben Maynard J. Clerk

The Town by their vote accepted of the Warning of this Meet-
-ing

at a Legal Town Meeting held in Sudbury, on December the 12th of 93 proceeded to the Consideration of the 1st Art^l and 1st Chose Mr. Isaac Maynard Moderator - The Question was then put, to see, if the Town, would build a new Meeting House, and it pass^d in the affirmative, 50 for Building, 44 against it

2^d The Question was then asked, to see if the Town, would Choose a Corner, to Look out, a Convenient Spot of Land, to Erect, a House upon, and it pass^d in the negative. The Question was then put, to see, if the Town, would Erect sd^d House, as near the present Meeting House, as the Circumstances of the Land, would admit of, and it pass^d in the Negative, The Question was then asked to see, whether the Town, would have the New House, Erected as near the Spot, on which the old one, Now stands as possible, and it pass^d in the negative
