2<sup>d</sup> Article The Question, was then asked, To See, if the Town, would Choose a Comtee, for the purpose, of finding the Centre of Travel, in S<sup>d</sup> Town, and it passed in the negative— Then the town took up the 1<sup>st</sup> Article again.— and the Question was put, To See, if the Town, would Erect, the New Meeting House, at the Crook of Road, in M<sup>r</sup>. Peter Haynes Land, and it passed in the negative— The Question, was then asked To See, if the Town, would Erect, Said House as near the Spot on which the present Meeting house, Now stands, as the Situation, of the Land, will conveniently admitt. and it passed in the affirmative. By 56 to 40— then Voted, to Choose a Comtee, for the purpose of Staking out a Spot of ground, whereon to Erect a New Meeting house in Said Town, Draughting a plan, and to report what Sum of Money, in their Opinion, will be Sufficient, to proceed to the building Said House, Said Comtee to Consist of Seven,— Comtee Chosen, were Esq<sup>r</sup>. Rice, Col<sup>l</sup> Rice, Col<sup>l</sup>. Sarsin, Capt. Thompson, M<sup>r</sup>. Jones, Capt. Whaler, & Capt. Goodnow. Then Voted, to add Two More to Said Comtee Viz D<sup>r</sup>. Walker, & Capt. Levi Holden— Said Comtee to Report, at the adjournment of the Meeting, — then Voted to adjourn this Meeting to this day fortnight, at 1 o'clock afternoon, to Meet at this place, —

Sudbury Monday Jan<sup>y</sup> 20<sup>th</sup> 1794.

The town being well agreeable to the foregoing adjournment, proceeded and called for the report of their Comtee chosen, for Staking out a Spot of ground, on which to Erect a New Meeting House, Draughting a plan, &c. &c. which report was presented, and Read before the Town,— then Voted, that Each paragraph in Said report, should be put up Separate— The Question was then asked To See, if the Town, would accept of the report, so far as respects the Spot of Ground, Staked out, on which to Erect a New Meeting House,— & it passed in the negative.— then Voted, that the Comtee aforesaid, should Immediately proceed, to Stake out another Spot, of ground, whereon to Erect S<sup>d</sup> House, & report to the Town, forthwith— Then the Town attended to the report, of their Comtee, who reported, that the South East Corner, of the New Meeting House, should be Erected 19 feet Back in a parallel Line, with the East End of the Old Meeting House, and that S<sup>d</sup> House should Extend, North & West.— which Report was by vote, accepted, by 57 to 37.— The Question was then put, To See, if the Town, would accept the report, of the Comtee, as Exhibited, respecting the Length & Breadth of the House, which—
