

March Anno Domini 1794. S S

These are to Notify & Warn, all the Freeholders, & other Inhabitants, of the town of Sudbury, Qualified as the Law directs, to vote in Town affairs, to Meet at the Meeting House, in Said town, on Monday the 3^d day of March next, at 1 o'clock afternoon, on Said day, then and there.

1st To Choose a Moderator, Town Clerk, Selectmen, Town Treas^r, Assessor, Constables, and all Other Town Officers, Required by Law, to be Annually Chosen, in the Months of March or April.

2^d To See, if the Town will repair their Highways, by a rate the present year, and Grant a Suitable Sum of Money, for Repairing the Same.

3^d To See, if the Town will Give Liberty, for Swine, to go at Large, the present year.

4th To See, if the Town will Give Liberty, for Horses, to Go at Large Without Letters, any part of the present year, from the first day of April, to the Last day of Sept^r next.

5th To See, if the Town will Give Liberty, for Sheep, to Go at Large, from the 15th day of March, to the first day of April next.

6th To See, if the Town, will accept the Settlements, of the Selectmen, with the Town Treas^r, and Order the same to be Recorded.

7th To See, if the Town, will, agreeable to the request of Col^l Lawin, Choose an Agent, or agents, to appear at the Court of Sessions next to be holden at Concord, for the purpose of preventing the Laying out any new County Road, through the Town. Do or act as the Town shall think proper when Mett.

8th To See, if the Town, will accept the List of Jurors, As presented by the Selectmen.
