4th To See, if the Town, agreeable to the Petition of, Aaron Maynard, & others, will Grant S^d. Petitioners, the Privilege, of their School Money, for a Reason, set forth in said Petition. Reference thereto being had. Do, or act as the Town shall think proper when Met.

5th To See, if the Town, agreeable to the Petition of, Isaac Puffer, will grant him the privilege, of Erecting a Small Building Back of the Common, & upon the Easterly End of said Common, Reference being had to S^d. Petition. Do or act. &c &c.

6th To See, if the Town, will take any Measures, for the Recovery, of a Dower, out of a certain Tract of Land, situated in Rutland, & formerly Owned by Edward Groat Jun^r, Late Husband, of the Widow Lydia Groat, of this Town Do or act. &c &c.

7th To See, if the Town, will make provision, for supplying the Town, with Six Camp Fire Kettles, agreeable to Law.

8th To See, if the Town, will Order their Treas^r, to pay their agents, appointed to appear in Behalf of said Town, at the Court of Sessions, for the purpose of opposing, the Laying out any New County roads, through S^d. Town, out of any Money, that may be Unappropriated, in the Treasury. Do or act &c &c.

9th To See, if the Town, will accept the List of Jurors, as Presented by the Selectmen.
