6th Article. Then voted, to Choose one person, as a Committee, for the purpose, ~~mentioned~~ in this Article, & Col^d Jon^a Rice was appointed, and Empower'd to, act in a Discretionary Manner, with regard to the Recovery of said Dower, as Circumstances shall render necessary, ---

6th Article, in the warning of March Meeting, as Contain'd in this 2^d Article, accepted the Settlement of the Selectmen with the Town Treas^r & orderd the same to be Recorded ---

7th Article Directed their Treasurer, to Deliver to the Selectmen out of the Unappropriated Money, now in the Treasury, a Sufficient Sum of Money, to purchase Six Camp Fire Kettles for the use of the Town. ---

8th Art. Directed their Treas^r to pay their agents Seven Dollars as is Express in this Article ---

9th Art. put over to a May Meeting. ---
Then Lt. Uriah Moore Came into Town Meeting, & presented Lt. Asher Cutler, to serve as Constable, in his stead, which was put to vote, to see, if the Town would accept of ^{in his stead} Lt. Cutler, & it pass'd in the negative ---

Then voted to adjourn this Meeting to Col^d Benjamin Sawin, The Town being Mett. agreeable, to the foregoing adjournment proceeded, and voted to Dissolve this Meeting. ---
