

May Anno Domini 1794.

These are to Notify, and Warn, all the freeholders, and other Inhabitants, of the Town of Sudbury. Qualified, agreeable to the Constitution, of this Commonwealth, to vote, in the choice of a Representative, and all others, Qualified, as the Law directs, to vote in Town affairs, to Meet, at the meeting house in said Town, on Monday the 5th Day of May next, at 1 o'clock afternoon, on sd day then & there.

1st To Elect, or depute, some Suitable Person, being a Freeholder, and resident, in said Town, to serve for, & Represent sd Town, in a great, & General Court, appointed to be Convened, held & kept, for the service of this Commonwealth, at the State House, in Boston, on Wednesday, the 28th day of May, next, agreeable to a Law, of the Commonwealth, in that case made and provided.

2^d To Choose a Moderator, and act upon the 4th & 9th Articles in the Warning of April Meeting, & Refered to May meeting, for further Consideration.

3^d To See, if the Town, will appropriate, for the use of Mr. Henry Smith, and others, a Sum of money, out of the Treasury, Equal, to their Proportion, of the School Money. Agreeable to a former Vote, of Town. Do or act, as the Town shall think proper when Met.

4th To See, if the Town, will take any Measures, for ascertaining the Bound, Between the Towns Land, Near the Meeting House, Do or act, &c &c.
