

May Anno Domini 1794.

Sudbury, Monday 5th day of May 1794. The Town being being Mett. Agreeable to the foregoing Warning, Proceeded to the Business of 1st day & voted. to send a Representative, to the General Court, the Year Ensueing. - & chose William Rice Esq^r. being a Freeholder, and resident in said Town, to serve for, & Represent. said Town, in General Court the Year Ensueing.

2^d Article. Chose William Rice Esq^r. Moderator. - and then proceeded, to the 4th Article, as Contained in this 2^d Article and the Question was put, To See, if the Town, would Grant 1st Petitioners, the Privilege of their School Money, as Set forth in 1st Article. & it passed in the negative.

3^d Article. the Question was put, to See, if the Town, would Grant to Henry Smith, & others, a Sum of Money, Equal to their part of the School Money, out of the Treasury, and it passed in the negative.

The Town then took up the 4th Article, again, as Contained in this 2^d Article, and the Question was put to See, if the Town, would Grant 1st Petitioners their Request, as Set forth in 1st Article, & it passed in the negative.

Then the Town, took up the 3^d Article again - and Voted, to appropriate, to Henry Smith, & others their proportion, of School Money, out of the unappropriated Money, now in the Treasury.

9th Article, as Contained in the 2^d Article of the warning of this meeting, Granted of the List of Jurors, as presented by the Selectmen.

11th Article, voted, to choose a Committee, for the purpose mentioned in this Article, and the Selectmen were appointed for that Purpose.

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
