The Town being Mett. Agreeable to the foregoing Warning. proceeded to the Business of said day. & chose Capt. Levi Holden Moderator. —

2^d Article. Voted. to Give to Each Soldier. that Shall Engage in the three Months Service. Mentioned in this Article. One Dollar ^{to be paid} as a Bounty. when he Shall pass Muster. & Two Dollars more. when he is Called upon to March. also to make them up Seven Dollars p^r. Month. Including the Continental Pay. if they after receiving Orders. Do march and Perform said Towns of Duty. as Requested by S^t. Orders —

3^d Article Voted to choose two persons. for the purpose Mentioned in this Article — and Col^l Rice & Cap^t. Wheeler were appointed. for the purpose aforesaid —

4th Article passed in the Negative. —

Then voted. that the Treas^r be Empowered to pay to each Soldier that Engages in the Service aforesaid. when he passes Muster. one Dollar. out of any Unappropriated Money. Or to Borrow Money on the Towns credit. —

Then the Town by their vote
