Sudbury Monday Sept. 29th 1794.

The town being Mett. agreeable to the foregoing adjournment. & the Moderator of this meeting, Not being present. proceeded, & Chose Capt. Levi Holden Moderator. pro. temp. pore. Then proceeded, & called upon the Comtee for report. chosen to ascertain the Centre of Graviti in said town — who Reported, that a part of said Comtee had Mett. and after a Considerable Debate. had, upon the advantage, or Disadvantage arising from a Measurement of the Town, — Finally agreed to go on and Measure, provided, the Comtee for the aggrieved party, would assist. ~~There~~ who were accordingly notified. But seemed averse to a Measurement. — by suggesting as there was an Order of Government, for an accurate plan of the Town, it might be ascertained, by the persons chosen, for that purpose.

The Quet. was then put, to see, if the Town, would Direct their Affairs, to assist the Town, the sum of three Hundred pounds, which was Granted, upon the adjournment of this Meeting. & It passed in the Negative. — The Quet. was again put, to see, if the Town, would Direct their Affairs, to assist ~~the Town~~ the sum of £300 which was Granted, upon the adjournment of this meeting. ^(to be made in a separate Rate) & it passed in the affirmative. — It was then moved, & seconded to Dissolve this meeting. which being put to vote, passed in the Negative. Then voted, to adjourn this Meeting to the first Monday in Nov. Next, at 1 o'clock afternoon, to meet at this place.

Sudbury Monday Nov. 3rd 1794. — The Town Being Mett. agreeable to the foregoing adjournment. and the Quet. being put, to see, if the Town, would adjourn this Meeting, to five o'clock this afternoon, and it passed in the Negative. — It was then voted, to adjourn this Meeting, to this Day Week at 12 o'clock, to meet at this place.
