Sudbury, Monday 20th October 1794. — This Notification has been posted up, at the request of the Selectmen, & agreeable to a former vote, of the Town. — By Ruben Maynard, Clerk

The Town, by their vote, accepted the warning of this Meeting

Sudbury, Monday 20th Day of October, 1794. —

At a Legal Town Meeting, held in Sudbury, on the Day & Year Abovesaid, — proceeded to the Business of said Day, and Chose Col^l. Jos^{ph}. Rice for their Moderator. — Then

Article

2^d proceeded to the Second Article, and Granted, the Sum of Seventy four pound, as a Salary, to the Rev^d. M^r. Biglow. the year Ensueing. —

3^d Granted, the Sum of £50 for the Support of a Grammar School, the year Ensueing. —

The Question was then put to see, if the Town would make an Equal Division, of the £50 Granted, Between the five School Districts, and it passed in the negative. — Then voted to pass over the 3^d Article for the present. —

4th Granted the Sum of £20 for the support of a Reading & writing School, the year Ensueing. — to be Equally Divided, Between the five School Districts

Then the Town took up the 3^d Article again and voted, that the £50 Granted, for the Support, of a Grammar School, be Equally Divided Between the five School Districts. —

5th Article passed over for the present. —

Then allowed to Doct^r. Motman, an Acc^t. against Abahel Knight, for Doctoring the Widow Thankfull Goodenow. — To ^{Sundry} Vizits & Medicines, from the 5th of May 1789, to March 13th 1791. ~~£ 14 12 8~~ full of his acc^t. (he giving S^d. Knight a Discharge for the same)

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Allowed To Doct^r. Motman, for Doctoring Obadiah Moore from 20th Oct^r. 1792. to Nov^r. 4th To vizits & Medicines, 15/ in full of his acc^t. —

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
