Sudbury Monday Nov^r 3^d 1794

The town Being Mett. agreeable to the foregoing adjournment — provided & took up the 8th Article, and Granted the Sum of Nine pound Six Shillings, for the purpose of paying to each Soldier, that has Engaged in the three month Service. One Dollar when he shall pass Muster, 9 6 "
