9th To See, if the town, will appoint, an Agent or Agents, to appear in Behalf of said town, at the Court of Sessions, Next to be Holden at Comore, in & for the County of Middlesex to Oppose the Acceptance, of a road Laid out in the Northwesterly part of the town, and make provision for the payment, of the Expence, that has, or may arise, in consequence of said Opposition. — Do Or Act &c. —

10th To See, if the town, will give directions to their Selectmen, (to Render Less Expensive) the support of the poor, in said town — Do or act, &c. —

11th To See, if the town, will Build a School House in the Center District, & sell it as near the Meeting House, as conveniently may be, — also to Build houses in any other of the Districts, in said town, — Or Repair the Old School Houses, as shall be found Necessary, — Also to make such Alterations in the District, as the town shall think Necessary — Or Do or act, &c. &c. —

And make Due return of this Order, with your doings thereon, to the Selectmen, Or Town Clerk, at time & place above mentioned —
