Then Voted, to Excuse, Lt. Hopkille Willis, from serving as Fish Warden, And W^r. Jeduthon Willis, was chosen in his Room, Also, Excused W^r. Aaron Johnson, from serving as a Fish Driver, and Col^o Ben^r. Sawin was appointed in his stead.
