Then Order you, to Notify, & Warn, all the Freeholders, & Other Inhabitants, (Belonging to your ward, in Sudbury) Qualifi-
=ed, as is provided in the Constitution, of this Common-
=wealth, to vote, in the choice of a Governor, Lt. Gover-
=nor, & Senators, for the year Ensueing, & all Others, Qual-
=ified, as the Law directs, to vote, in town affairs, to
Meet, at the Meeting House in said town, on Monday
the 6th Day of April next, at 1 o'clock, Afternoon.
on said Day. Then & There,

1st To Bring in their votes, for a Governor, Lt. Governor,
& Senators, for the year Ensueing.

2^d To Choose a Moderator, & Act upon the 6th 8th 10th and
11th Articles in the Warning of March Meeting, & put Over
to April Meeting, for further Consideration.

3^d To fill up Vacancies, in those ^{Town} Offices, which the Law Requires,
Should any Office appear to be Vacant.

4th To See, if the town, will Order the publick Roads in said
Town, to be Widened, Agreeable to Original Laying out
Agreeable to the request, of Capt. Bowker, - Do Or act as the
Town shall think proper when Mett.

5th To See, what Method, the town, will take, for the future, for
Warning of town Meetings. - Do Or act &c.

6th To See, if the town, will take Measures, to procure the
Relinquishment, of a fine, which it is said the town, stand
Liable to pay, for Not keeping a Grammar School, as the
Law directs. - Do Or act. &c.

7th To See, if the town, will take Measures, for Repairing
Or Building, a New Pound. - Do Or act. &c.
