Abel Thompson, and Mr. Charles Haynes, was chosen to said Office, & sworn, by W^m Rice Esq^r — Then chose Mr. Abel Willis Fish ^{warden} ~~warden~~, in stead of Mr. Jed^d Willis — Then voted, to choose Mr. Abel Willis, from serving Fish warden, — and Mr. Sam^l Gleason, was chosen in this stead. —

4th Article, Put Over to May Meeting, for further consideration

5th Article, voted, that that the Notifications for town Meeting be posted up, at the Meeting House, as usual —

6th Article put over to May Meeting —

7th voted, to choose a Committee of three Persons, for the purpose ~~of taking into consideration~~ of taking into consideration, whether it be best, to repair the Old pound, or to Build a New One, and what kind of a pound in their Opinions, would be Best, to Build, & to report to the town, at the Next Annual May Meeting. Com^{tee} chosen, were Col^o Sawin, Capt. Wheeler, & Dr. Walker. —
