

May Ann'd Domine 1795. —

These are to notify, & Warn, all the Freemen & other Inhabitants, of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified, Agreeable to the Constitution, of this Commonwealth, to vote, in the choice of a Representative, and all Others, Qualified, as the Law directs, to vote, in town affairs, to Meet at the Meeting House in said Town, On Wednesday, the Sixth Day of May next, at 4 o'clock, afternoon. On said Day, then & there, —

1<sup>st</sup> To Chose, or Depute, Some Suitable Person, being a Freemen, & Resident, in said Town, to serve for and Represent, said Town, in a great, & General Court, Appointed to be Conven'd, held, & kept, for the Service of this Commonwealth, at the State House in Boston, On Wednesday the 27<sup>th</sup> Day of May next, Agreeable to a Law, of this Commonwealth, in that Case made and Provided. —

2<sup>d</sup> To See, if the Town, will Express their Sentiments with Regard to the Necessity, or Expediency, of Revising the Constitution, in Order to Amendments — Agreeable to a Resolve of the Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Legislature of this Commonwealth, of the 9<sup>th</sup> of Feb. 1795. —

3<sup>d</sup> To Bring in their Votes, for a County Register, that Office, Still Remaining Vacant. —

4<sup>th</sup> To Chose a Moderator, & set upon the 8<sup>th</sup> Article in the Warning of March Meeting, & upon the 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> Articles, in the Warning of April Meeting, and Report to May Meeting, for further Consideration. —

5<sup>th</sup> To See, if the Town, will take Measures, for paying the Expence that has, or may arise, On account of preaching, that has or may be provided, During the Confinement of the Rev<sup>d</sup> M<sup>r</sup>. Biglow — Do for Act as the Town shall think proper when Mett —
