Sudbury, Monday 8th Day of June 1795 - At
a Legal town Meeting held in Sudbury, on the Day
& Year Abovesaid, - proceeded, & took up the 1st Article
& Chose Capt. Samuel Puffer. Moderator. ---

= Then Voted, to adjourn, this Meeting, for half an hour,
then to Meet, at Col^{le}. Benj^m. Sawin. ---

= The town being Mett, Agreeable to the foregoing adjourn-
ment, proceeded, - & took up the 2^d Article - & the

2^d Question was put, to see, if the town, would accept of
Col^{le}. Sawin's yard, & New Barn, for a Pound, for the year
Enuing, and it passed in the Affirmative. ---

Then the town by this Vote, Disolved this Meeting

Town, and set 2^d Houses, as near where the present Meet-
ing-House, now stands, as conveniently may be, ---
Do Orcht, as the Town, shall think proper, when Mett, ---

3^d To see, if the Town, will accept, of a plan, for said
House, which was Drawn by Capt. Thompson, Or
Such other plan, as the Town, shall think Best,
Do Orcht, &c. ---

4th To see, if the Town, will chuse a committee, to
Build said House, in such a way, and Under such
Restrictions, as the town, shall direct, said Com-
= mittee, to Lett out the Building said House, at
