Sudbury, 5th Day of Oct^r. 1795. — at a Legal Town Meeting held in Sudbury, On the Day, & Year abovesaid. Proceeded, to the Business of said day, and made choice of — William Rice Esq^r. for their Moderator. —

2^d Article, Voted to Build a Meeting-House, in said Town. — and that said House, Should be Erected, upon the common Land, Near to the present Meeting-House. — It was Then Voted, That the Meeting-House to be Erected, the South, & West, Cells, of said House, Should Occupy, the Ground, on which the South, and West, Cells, of the present Meeting-House, Now stand upon. — and that the Enlargement, of the New Meeting House, Should extend, North and East. —
