3^d To See, if the Town, will take Measures, for removing the present Meeting-House, and Other Obstructions, off, of the Ground, where the Town, Voted, to Erect a new Meeting-House upon, Or appoint some Other place, on the Common, to Sett the new House upon, also, to See, if the Town, will take Measures, for Disposing of the old Meeting-House, Or do Or Act, any Other way, on this Article, as the Town, shall think proper, when Mett, —————

4th To See, if the Town, will, Agreeable to the request, of W^m Wheeler, make him any further Compensation, for his Services, Respecting the Building the Mill Bridge in said Town, ————— Do Or Act, &c &c —————

5th To See, if the Town, will take Measures, for supplying the several School-Houses, with wood, the year ensuing. ————— Do Or Act, &c —————

6th To See, if the Town, will appropriate, some part of the Ground, Left for Body Seats, in the new Meeting-House, into Pew ground, Agreeable, to the request, of Isaac Puffer, ————— Do Or Act, &c —————
