- Then Voted, that the Town should go into a Com^{tee} of the whole for the purpose, of Viewing, & Agreeing upon the Most Suitable Spot of Ground, on the Common, whereon to Erect the New Meeting-House, also Voted to adjourn this Meeting, for one Quarter of an hour, for the purpose aforesaid - then to meet at this place. =
- The town being Well Agreeable, to the Aforegoing Adjournment, = The Qu^{est} was put to see, if the Town, would set the New Meeting-House, one half the width to the West of the present Meeting House, & it pass'd in the Negative =
- The Qu^{est} was then put, to see if the Town, would Erect the New Meeting House, upon the Hill where the old Belong formerly stood, & it pass'd in the Negative. =
- The Qu^{est} was again put to see, if the Town, would set the New House upon the most convenient spot of Ground, up South East of the road that Leads to Mr. Johnsons, on which the school House now stand, & it pass'd in the Negative =
- The Qu^{est} was then Asked, to see, if the Town, would set the New House, one half the width of the House, to the West of the present House, & that the Enlargement should Extend North, & it pass'd in the Negative, =
- 2^d Then the Town took up the second Article Again, and Voted, to put Over the Granting of the Money, for the purpose Mentioned in this Art^e to the Next March Meeting =
- It was then Voted, to add two more, to the Com^{tee} which were Chosen, for the purpose of Disposing of the old Meeting House, Com^{tee} added, were Mr. Isaac Maynard & Dr. Walker =
- also Voted that the Major part, of said Com^{tee} be Empowered, to transact, the Business, for which they were appointed. =
- Then Voted that the Money, Arising from the sale, of the old Meeting House, be paid into the Town Treas^{ry}, & to be Appropriated, for the Express purpose, of Building the New Meeting-House, and to be Drawn from the Town Treasury, By Order of the Selectmen, =
- It was then Voted, to Dissolve this Meeting =
