These are to Notify & warn, all the Freeholders, and other Inhabitants, of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified, as the Law Directs, to Vote, in Town affairs, to Meet, at the Meeting House, in said Town, on Monday, the 4th Day of January, Next at 2, o Clock Afternoon, on said Day, then & there.

1st To choose a Moderator.

2^d To see, if the Town will Grant, a Suitable sum of Money, for the purpose of making up the Deficiency in the Last year Schooling, Do or act, as the Town shall think proper, when Met.

3^d To see, if the Town, will Grant, or appropriate, a Suitable sum of Money, for the purpose of Refunding to Henry Smith, & Others, their proportion of the School Money, which was Granted, in Oct. 1794, Do, or act, as the Town shall think proper.
