These are to Notify, & Warn all the Freeholders, & Other Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified, as the Law Directs, to Vote, in Town Affairs to Meet, at the Meeting House, in Said Town, on Monday the 7th Day of March Next, at 1 o'clock Afternoon, on said Day, then & there, - - -

1st To Choose a Moderator, Town Clerk, Selectmen, Town Treas^r, Assessors, Constables, and all other Town Officers, Required by Law, to be annually chosen, in the Month of March, or April. - - -

2^d To See, if the Town, will repair their Highways, by a Rate, the present year, & Grant a suitable Sum of Money, for repairing the same, - - -

3^d To See, if the Town, will give liberty, for Swine to Go at large, the present year. - - -

4th To See, if the Town, will give liberty, for Horses to Go at large, without fetters any part of the present year, from the first Day of April, to the last Day of September. - - -
