8th Article. The Question, was then put, To see, if the Town, would Appoint, some other place, on the Common, to set the New Meeting-House upon. Other than that Heretofore Agreed upon - & it Passed in the Negative.

Then Voted that the Highway Grant, & the 1360 Dollars Granted, for the purpose of Building a Meeting-House, be made into Rates forthwith.

9th Voted, that the Grammar School be kept in the New School House, in the South East District one Month.

10th Article Passed to April Meeting, for further Consideration.

11th Directed, their Selectmen to provide some Suitable & Secure place, for depositing, the Towns Stock of Ammunition.

12th Then Voted, that the Committee, chosen for the purpose mentioned in this Article be directed, to buy a seat in each of the Side Galleries.

Then Voted, to Dissolve this Meeting.
