5th Article It was then voted, that the Town, should take some Effectual Measures, for the Uniting, of the people in the South East District, also voted, that the Money Granted for the purpose of Schooling, the present year should be kept out, in the New School House, in S. E. District.

6th Art. put over to May Meeting, for further Consideration.

7th Empowered their Com^{tee} chosen for the purpose of superintending the Building a New Meeting-House in said Town, to take Measures for Removing the old Buildings off, of the Common, or any part of them, and to Direct, where the New Buildings, shall be Erected for the future.

9th Attended to the Report of their Committee as mentioned in this Art. which Report was Rejected. - The Question was then put, To see, if the Town, would Direct the select men, to afford any Assistance, toward the support of the wife, of Mr. Isaac Hunt, & it passed in the Negative. Then voted, to Dissolve this Meeting.
