for a pound keeper, — also appoint some suitable place
for a pound, or pounds, in S^d Town, Do Or Act &c.
- 5th To see, if the Town, will take Measures for Collat-
ing of the Highway Taxes, heretofore Granted, & not wor-
ked out, Do or act &c &c.
- 6th To see, if the Town, will take Measures, for providing
some suitable place, for ~~the~~ Holding publick Worship in,
on the Lord's Day, through the ensuing Summer Do
- 7th To see, if the Town, will appoint a school
Committee, for the year ensuing, — Do Or act, &c &c.
- 8th To see, if the Town, will take Measures, for Repair-
ing or Rebuilding of Landham Bridge, Do or act &c.
- 9th To see, if the Town, will appropriate some part
of the Body, of the New Meeting House, sufficient to
erect two pews upon, & Direct the Committee to
sell the same — Do Or act &c &c.
