Sudbury, May 9th 1796, This Notification, has been
Posted up, at the Request of the Selectmen, & Agreeable to
a Late Vote, of the Town. By Oliver Maynard, Clerk

Sudbury May 9th 1796, — At a Legal Town
Meeting held in Sudbury, on the Day & Year Above said,
proceeded to the 1st Article, and the Question being put, to
See, if the Town, would send a Representative, to the Ge-
neral Court, the ensuing year, which passed in the Ne-
gative.

2^d Article Made Choice of Col^{le}. Jos^{ph}. Rice for this Modera-
tor, 6th Article as Contained in this 2^d Article passed over
for the present.

3^d Made Choice of M^r. Gideon Richardson, for Surveyor, of 4th
Highways in the S. E. District, instead of M^r. Abel Ridd.

4th Made Choice of Col^{le}. Benj^m. Sawin, for a Pound. Keeper
for the Year ensuing, — also Voted, that Col^{le}. Benj^m. Sawin
New Barn, & Yard, Adjoining the same, be appointed
for a pound, for the Use of the Town, for the ensuing
year.

5th Voted, to take No Order upon this Article.

6th Voted, that the Selectmen, be Empowered, to provide some
Suitable place, or places, for the purpose of holding pub-
lik Worship in, During the Summer Season.

7th The Question, was put, to See, if the Town, would choose a
School Committee, & it passed in the Negative.

8th The Question was put, to See, if the Town, would Choose a Com-
mittee, for the purpose Mentioned in this Article and
it passed in the Negative.

9th The Question was put to See, if the Town, would appropriate
three of the Back Seats, in the Body of the Meeting House,
on the mans side, & three of the Back Seats, on the Womens
Side, ~~into~~ for the purpose of Erecting 6 pews upon, & it passed
in the Negative.

6th Article as Contained in this 2^d Article put over to Oct. Meeting.
Then the Town, by their Vote Disbanded
this Meeting.
