6th To see, if the Town, will Grant Money, to pay their Treas^r and Officers, the present year. —

7th To see, if the town, will act, upon the 6th Article in the Warning of April Meeting, & upon the 3^d Article, in the ^{May} Warning of Meeting, & refer, to Oct^r Meeting, for further Consideration. — Do Or act, &c. &c.

8th To see, if the Town, will Build a pound, Or pounds, in said Town. — Do Or act. &c. —

9th To see, if the Town, will Order, where the towns Mark of Ammunition shall be Deposited. Do Or act. &c. &c.

10th To see, if the Town, will make provision for Defraying the necessary Expenses of Stone work, in Building the new Meeting House, in said town, & Not Included, in the Contract, for Building said house. — Do Or act &c.

11th To see, if the Town, will Lengthen out the time, for Completing the Leveling the ground, Round the Meeting House, — also for Committing the Rate Bills to the Collectors. — Do Or act &c.
