

October Anno Domini 1796

Sudbury Monday, October the 13th 1796

At a Legal Town Meeting, held in Sudbury on the Day & year Abovesaid, - provided to the Business of said Day -

& made choice of Col^d Jos^{ph} Rice for Moderator.

Article 2^d Granted the sum of 246 Dollars, 66 cents, & 7 Mills as a Salary to the Rev^d W^m Biglow the year ensuing 246.66.7

3^d Granted the sum of 250 Dollars, for the support of a Grammar School, the year ensuing, to be Equally Divided, Between the five School Districts 250. . .

4th Granted the sum of 166 Dollars 66 cents, & Seven Mills, for the support, of a reading & writing School, to be Equally Divided, Between the five School Districts 166.66.7

Also Granted the sum of 40 Dollars, to supply the Three School Districts with Wood, the year ensuing, to be Equally Divided, Between said Districts 40. . .

Then the Town by their Vote, pass^d Over to the 11th Article, & Voted, to Lengthen out the time, for committing the Rate Bill, to the collectors, to the first of June in the year 1797.

Then the Town, by their Vote Adjourned, this Meeting to the 7th Day of Nov^r Next, at 1 o'clock Afternoon, to meet at this place.

The Town being Mett. Agreeable to the foregoing

Article 5th Adjournment, provided, & took up the & Granted the sum of 266 Dollars, 66 cents & 7 Mills, for the support, of the Poor, in said town the year ensuing. 266.66.7

6th Granted to pay their Treas^r the present year, the sum of 10. . .
{ to pay their Assessors, the sum of 13.33.3

7th Voted, to pass Over this Article, for the present 993.33.4

8th The Town by their Vote Appointed Col^d Sawins New Barn, & had, Adjoining the same, for a Pound, for the Towns use, for the year ensuing.
