Decorations, as are Necessary, for the Pulpit, Do or act, &c -

5th To See, if the Town, will Grant, a suitable Sum of Money,
Or, otherways make provision, for to purchase, what is
Mentioned in the third & fourth Articles, Do, Or act, &c &c

6th To See, if the Town, will request, their Rev^d Pastor, to preach
a sermon, at the Dedication of the New Meetinghouse, - also to
appoint the time, when said house, shall be Dedicated, Do or act, &c
