9th The Town, by Vote Appropriated, to the use of the Singing Society in said Town, the Front Gallery, & so much of the Side Galleries Next the front, as shall be necessary, for their Accommodation, during the Towns pleasure, ~

10th Voted, to choose a Committee of one person, for the purpose express in this Article; & William Rice Esq^r was Appointed, ~ It was then Voted, to add two more to said Committee, & Col^{le} Jos^a. Rice, and M^r. John Maynard, were chosen, ~ the Town, also by Vote, Empowered either of said Committee, to pass deeds, in behalf of the Town, to the several purchasers, of pews, in the Meeting House, ~

11th Voted, to appoint, three Persons, as a Committee, for the purpose express in this article, & the following Gent^l. were chosen, Viz^t M^r. Isaac Maynard, Col^{le}. Sawin, and Deacon Tho^s. Walker, ~ ~ ~ ~ ~

Then the Town by their Vote Dissolved this Meeting ~

1st To choose a Moderator, Town Clerk, Selectmen, Town Treas^r, Assessor, Constables, & all other Town Officers, required by Law, to be annually chosen, in the Month, of March or April, ~ ~ ~ ~ ~

2^d To see, if the Town, will repair their Highways, by a rate, the present year, & Grant a Suitable Sum of Money, for repairing the same, ~ ~ ~ ~ ~
