

March Anno Domini 1797

- 3rd To see, if the Town, will give liberty for Swine to go at large the present year,
- 4th To see, if the Town, will give liberty for Horses to go at Large, without fetters, any part of the present year, from the first day of April, to the Last day of September,
- 5th To see, if the Town, will give liberty for Sheep to go at Large, from the 15th day of March, to the 1st day of May next.
- 6th To see, if the Town, will Acept the Settlement of the Selectmen, with the Town Treas^r, & Order the same to be recorded,
- 7th To See, what Method, the Town will take, for warning their Town Meetings, for the future, Do or act at the Town, shall think proper when mett,
- 8th To See, if the Town, will Purchase a Quantity of Glasp. of Capt. Holden for the purpose of replacing such Squares as shall be broke in the Meeting House, do or act. &c
- 9th To See, if the Town, will Erect a house, or other ways, make provision, for the reception of the poor, in said Town, Do or act, &c &c
- 10th To see, if the Town, will allow Interest upon an Order, given by the Selectmen, in favour of M^r. John Maynard, Agreeable to S^r. Maynard request, Do or act &c
- 11th To see, if the Town, will Erect, a School House, in the Centre district. Do, or act. &c
- 12th To see, if the Town, will direct the Selectmen, to lay out a road, through M^r. Daniel Osborns land, to land of M^r. Ruben Rice - agreeable to S^r. Rice request. Do - or. act, &c &c
- 13th To see, if the Town, will Purchase a Blank book, for the Towns use, for the purpose of recording Deeds, of the Sale of P^{ro}p^{erty}, do - or - act, &c &c
