- 2^d Art^{le} Voted, to repair their Highways, by a rate, the present year, & the sum of one Thousand Dollars, was granted, for repairing the same, also Voted, that the price of Labour be for a man, one Dollar pr Day, for a yoke of oxen Two thirds of a Dollar & for a Cart, Twenty two Cents pr Day &c
- 3^d Article, Passed in the Negative
- 4th Article Passed in the Negative
- 5th Passed in the Negative
- 6th Accepted the Settlement, of the Selectmen with the Town Treas^r & ordered the same to be recorded
- 7th Voted, that the warrants, for the warning of Town Meetings for the future, be posted up at the Meeting House
- also Voted, that there be a box, provided, with a Large Square of Glass, ^{front} of the same, of a Sufficient Size to contain
- 8^d Warrant, Said Box, to be fastened up at the front End, of the Tower, of the Meeting House also appointed
- Capt^t Levi Holden, to procure Said Box,
- 8th Voted, to purchase thirty Squares of Glass of Capt^t Levi Holden, at the rate of twenty Cents pr Square, for the purpose Express^d in this article
- It was then Voted, that the remaining Articles Not acted upon, be put over to April Meeting, for further consideration
- Then the Town, by their Vote dissolved this Meeting
