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There are to Notify, & Warn, all the Freeholders, & Other Inhabitants, of the Town of Sudbury. Qualified, as is provided in the Constitution of this Commonwealth, to Vote, in the choice of a Governor, Lt. Governor, & Senators, for the Year ensuing & all other Qualified as the Law directs, to Vote in Town Affairs, to meet at the Meeting-House, in sd. Town, On Monday the 3^d Day of April Next, at 1 o'clock Afternoon on said day, then, & there

1st To Bring in their Votes, for Gov^r. Lt. Gov^r. & Senators for the Year ensuing.

2^d To Choose a Moderator, & act upon the 9th 10th 11th 12th & 13th Articles, in the Warning of March Meeting, & refer to April Meeting, for further consideration.

3^d To fill up Vacancies, in those Town Officers, which the Law requires, Should any Office appear to be Vacant.

4th To see, if the Town, will accept the list of Jurors, as presented by the Selectmen.

5th To see, if the Town, will repair, or rebuild Sandham Bridge, Agreeable to the request of Capt. Joseph Goodnow Do or act, as the Town shall think proper when Met.

6th To see, if the Town, will dispose of a certain piece of Highway, Near Hart pond, So called, agreeable to the request of W^m. John Brigham. Do, or, act, &c &c

7th To see, if the Town, will direct, the Selectmen, to take Isaac Moore's Children, & bind them out, to Good Masters, Agreeable to the petition of Capt. Levi Hobbs, representative being had, to sd. petition, Do or act, &c &c
