- 2^d Article - Chose William Rice Esq^r Moderator, the 9th Article, in the Warning of March Meeting, as contained in this 2^d Article the Qu^r was put to see, if the Town, would erect a House, for the reception of the poor, in S^t. Town, & it pass^d in the Negative - 10th Art^e as contained in this 2^d Art^e Put Over, to Next Oct^r. Meeting, for further Consideration, - 11th Article, as contained, in this 2^d Art^e, The Qu^r was ask^d, to see, if the Town, would erect a school House, in the Centre district, as Mention^d in this Article, & it pass^d in the Negative - 12th Art^e as contained in this 2^d. The Qu^r was put, to see, if the Town, would direct the Selectmen, to Lay out a road, as Mention^d in this Art^e & it pass^d, in the Negative - 13th as contained, in this 2^d Art^e. The Qu^r was put, to see, if the Town, would purchase a Blank Book, for the purpose, Mention^d in this Art^e & it pass^d in the Negative -
- 3^d Article - The Town by Vote & award, W^m. Edward Baynⁿ - ton, from Serving, as a Tythingman, & W^m. Jonⁿ. Fairbank - was chosen in his Stead, - Then M^r. Abner Walker, came into Town Meeting, & declar^d his Non accep^tance, of the Office, of a Constable, - & L^t. David Haw, was Chosen in his Stead, -
- 4th Accepted, of the List of Jurors, as present^d, by the Selectmen,
- 5th Voted, that the Selectmen, should proceed, & View the Bridge Mention^d in this Article, and that it be left discretionary, with them, either, to repair, or rebuild, said Bridge, as shall appear to be most for the Interest of the Town, -
- 6th Empower^d Deacon Walker, to View the Highway as Mention^d in this Article, and that he should act with regard to the Disposing, or Not Disposing of it, as it shall appear to him most for the Towns Interest, -
