- 9th To see, if the Town, will attend, to the report of the Com^{tee} Appointed, to settle the Line, Between the Towns, of Sudbury, & Stow, Do or act. &c &c
- 10th To see, if the Town, will take any Measures, respecting a Settlement, with M^r. Aaron Johnson, for a purchase of Land ^{to be made}, by said Johnson, of the Towns committee, appointed to sell, Lancaster old road, - also a note of hand, given for the aforesaid purchase. - Do, or act. &c &c
- 11th To see, if the Town, will, Agreeable to the request of Capt. Jonas Holden, give any further Encouragement, than Government has given, to the Towns proportion of Men, called upon by Government, to Enlist, for twelve Months service, Do, or act. &c
- 12th To see, if the Town, will Build, ^{provide a} pound in said Town, also to choose a pound keeper, Do, or act. &c &c
- 13th To see, if the Town, will provide some suitable place, for Depositing the Towns Stock of Ammunition, Do, or act. &c
- 14th To see, if the Town, will, take Measures, for rebuilding Landham Bridge, Do or act &c &c
- 15th To see, if the Town, will erect a school House, in the Centre District, Do or act. &c &c
- 16th To see, if the Town, will accept of a Highway, as Laid out, by the selectmen, from the Causeway, Near Captain Jon^s. Bents, to Concord road, Near Abiel Hornum, Do, or act.
- 17th To see, if the Town, will call upon their Com^{tee} for report, Appointed for the purpose, of selling a Highway, Near, Hart pond. - Do or act &c &c
- 18th To see, if the Town, Agreeable to the request of M^r. Isaac Wier, will take Measures, to open the road, Called pinner, Wash road, Near M^r. John Goodnow, Do or act. &c &c
- 19th To see, if the Town, will grant, a suitable sum of Money, for the purpose, of Leveling the ground round the meeting-House - also to Direct where the New Stables, shall be Erected for the future, Do or, act. &c
- 20th To see, if the Town, will, appoint a Man, to take care of & sweep the Meeting-House, Ring the Bell, & Dig Graves, as occasion may be, the year ensuing. -
- 21st To see, if the Town, will take Measures, to prevent L^t. Peter Smiths, becoming Expensive to said Town, Do, or act.
- 22^d To see, if the Town, will make any provision, for the payment, of some outstanding orders, against said Town
- 23^d To see, if the Town will take any measures, to prevent Josiah Cutler's family becoming chargeable to said Town, if Application should be made, for their support. Do, or act. &c &c
