Sudbury October, 30th 1797. This Notification, has been
Posted up, at the Desire, of the Selectmen, & Agreeable to
the Towns Vote. — Dr. Reuben Maynard, T. Clerk.
Warning Accepted —

At a Legal Town Meeting held in Sudbury on Monday the
30th Day of Oct. 1797. provided, & took up the 1st Article
& made choice, of Col. John Rice, for their Moderator.

2^d Granted, the sum of \$ 246. 66. Cents & 7 Mills, as a S. C. M.
Salary, to the Rev. Mr. Biglow, for the year ensuing. 246. 66. 7.

It was then voted, to choose a Committee of three per-
sons, for the purpose of taking into consideration the
Additional sum of Money, to the Rev. Mr. Biglow
Salary, as mentioned in the 2^d Article & report to
the Town, as soon as may be conveniently, Com.
Appointed, were, William Rice Esq. Dr. Walker, &
St. James Puffer.

3^d Granted, the sum of \$ 250, for the support of
a Grammar School, the year ensuing, to be equal-
ly divided, Between the five school districts. 250. . . .

Also voted, that the money be kept out, in the Win-
ter Season, if suitable Master, can be procured.

4th Granted, the sum of \$ 166. 66. 7 Mills, for the sup-
port of a Reading & writing school the year en-
suing, to be equally divided, Between the five
School Districts.

Also granted, the sum of \$ 40, to supply the five
School Districts with wood, the year ensuing, to
be equally divided, Between said Districts. 40. . . .

5th Granted, the sum of \$ 450, for the support of
the poor, in said Town, the year ensuing. 450. . . .

6th Granted, to pay, their Treas. the present year. 10. . . .

Granted, to pay their Assessors the present year. 13. 33. 3.

7th Voted, that this Article be passed over, untill Dr. Wal-
ker, presents his Accounts, to the Town, in order
for Settlement, then to be acted upon.

8th Granted, the sum of \$ 30, for the purpose & part
in this Art. — also Appointed, a Com. for the
purpose of procuring a singing master, & providing
a suitable place, to keep said school in, Com.
Chosen were, Mr. Sam. Puffer & Mr. John May-
nard, Junr.

9th Voted, to pass over this Art. untill the Adjourn-
ment, of this meeting, then to be acted upon.
