

October Anno Domini 1797

10th Voted to choose a Committee of three persons, for the purpose of making a settlement with Mr. Aaron Johnson respecting a purchase of Land &c, as mentioned in this Article, Com^{tee} appointed, were William Rice Esq^r Cap^t Wheeler, & Cap^t Levi Holden,

11th Voted, to give to each Soldier, called upon by Government, as mentioned in this Article, Ten Dollars pr^o Month, including Continental pay, During the Time he shall be in public Service & to each Sergeant, twelve Dollars pr^o Month including Government pay, whilst in public Service

Then the Com^{tee} appointed for the purpose, of taking into Consideration, the Additional Sum of Money to the Rev^d Mr. Biglow's Salary, as mentioned in the 2^d Article, reported, that it was their unanimous Opinion, that \$200 Dollars in Addition to the Grant already made, for the year ensuing would not be more than Adequate, to the Rev^d Mr. Biglow's Salary when settled - which report was not accepted, nor rejected.

It was then Voted, that the Article, respecting the Additional Grant of Money, to the Rev^d Mr. Biglow, be put over to the Adjournment of this Meeting.

12th passed over to the Adjournment of this Meeting, then to be called upon,

Then the Town, by their Vote, adjourned this Meeting to this Day, fortnight, at 1 o'clock Afternoon, to Meet, at this place,

Sabbury Monday Nov^r 13th 1797

The Town, being Met^h agreeable to the foregoing Adjournment, provided, & took up the 12th Article.

12th The Question, was asked to see, if the Town, would Build a pound, in said Town, & it passed in the Affirmative.

It was then Voted, to choose a Com^{tee} of three persons, for the purpose of reporting, a suitable spot of Ground, whereon, to build a pound, in said Town, also the Dimensions of said pound, - & report, to the Town, this Afternoon, Com^{tee} appointed, were Cap^t Wheeler, Cap^t Bent & Mr. Eben^r Plympton,

9th The Town, by their Vote, Directed the Selectmen to perambulate the line, for the future, Between the Towns, of Sabury, & Stone, Agreeable to the plans, of said Towns, Returned into the Secretaries Office

Then the Town, by their Vote took up the 2^d Article, again 2^d & After a Considerable, Debate, upon the Subject Matter of this Article, the Question was put, to see, if the Town, would Grant to their Rev^d Minister, the sum of \$200 Dollars, as a Gratuity, for his services in the Ministry for the year ensuing Agreeable to the report, of their Com^{tee} & it passed in the Affirmative
