The Question, was then put, to see, if the Town, would Grant to their Rev^d Minister the sum of £ 26, as a Gratitude, for his services, in the Ministry, for the year ensuing, & it pass'd in the Affirmative,

Then the Committee, chosen for the purpose, of Viewing a suitable spot of Ground, whereon, to erect a pound, in said Town, reported, that said pound be erected upon the East End of the Burying-yard, the South side, to be erected, about ten feet North, of Lt. Ruben Rius Stone wall, the wall of said pound, to be 5 1/2 feet, in Height, with a Hewn stick of Chestnut, or white pine Timber, ten inches in height, upon the top thereof, the Burying yard wall, to form one side, of ~~said~~ said pound, to be thirty feet Square, within the walls, of the same, which report, was by Vote, Accepted

It was then Voted, to choose a Com^{tee} of three persons, for the purpose of letting out the Building said pound to some person, or persons, that will do it, the cheapest, & the best, Committee chosen, were Mr. John Brigham, Lt. Noah Moore, & Mr. Eben^r. Plympton,

It was then Voted, to Grant a sum of Money, for the purpose of Building said pound,

The Question, was then asked, to see, if the Town, would reconsider, the Vote respecting the Grant, of the Gratitude, of 26. £ to their Rev^d Minister, which was Granted, for his services, in the Ministry, for the year ensuing, & it pass'd in the Negative

13th The Town by their Vote, Directed the Selectmen, to provide, for some suitable place, for depositing the Towns Stock of Ammunition, at the Expence of the Town,

14th Voted, to choose a Com^{tee} of three persons, for the purpose of Rebuilding Landham Bridge, or Letting of it out, to some person, or persons, that will do it, the cheapest, & most, for the Interest of the Town, Com^{tee} chosen were Mr. Josiah Richardson, Capt. Levi Holden, & Lt. Bogle,

15th Voted, to Build a School-House, in the Centre District
also Voted, to Choose a Com^{tee} for the purpose of reporting a suitable spot of Ground, whereon to erect said House, & report to the Town, at the Adjournment, of this Meeting
Said Com^{tee} to consist of three persons, Viz^t. William Rius Esq^r. Mr. Eben^r. Plympton & Capt. Abner Weeks,

The Town then by their Vote Adjourned this Meeting to this Day Next night, at 1 o'clock, Afternoon, to Meet at this place
