

October Anno Domini 1797

Then the Town, by their Vote, Directed the Treas^r to pay forthwith to M^r. John Maynard, the sum of fifteen Pounds, out of any Money, Now in the Treasury, it being for an order in favour of said Maynard, against the Town.

23^d. The Town by their Vote, Directed, the Selectmen, to make, all necessary Enquiry, Respecting Josiah Cutters family belonging to said Town, Also Voted, to defray all the necessary Expense, arising from said Enquiry.

15th. Attended, to the Report of the Com^{tee} appointed, for the purpose, of reporting a suitable spot of ground, whereon to erect, a school House, in the Centre District, which report was, that said House, be erected, upon the Right, of Land, Between the Meeting-House, & M^r. Isaac Puffer, Noon House, it being near unto said Noon House, which report was not accepted.

It was then Voted, to Adjourn this Meeting, to this Day fortnight, at 1 o'clock Afternoon, to Meet, at the Meeting House.

Sudbury Monday December, 11th. 1797. The Town, being well agreeable to the foregoing Adjournment, proceeded, to the Business of said Day, & Allowed the following Aids Viz.
