- Town, a New, or making such Alterations, in any one, or all the Districts, as shall appear necessary. & it passed in the Affirmative.
- = Then Voted to choose one person, out of each district, as a Com^{tee} for the Above purpose, Com^{tee} appointed, were, for the Centre District Leg. Rice for the South East District Mr. Totham Goodnow, for the South West L. L. David How, for the North West, Col. Rice for the North East Capt. Wheeler.
- = also Voted, that, said Com^{tee} make report, of their proceedings, in said Business, at the Adjournment of this Meeting.
- = It was then Voted, to adjourn this meeting, to this Dayfortnight, at 1. o'clock, Afternoon, to meet at the Meeting House.
- = Sudbury, Monday, Dec^r. 11th 1797. The Town being most Agreeable to the foregoing adjournment, provided, & Voted, to Adjourn this meeting. To Mr. William Lawsons to Meet this Evening.
- = Monday Evening, Dec^r. 11th 1797.
- = The Town being most Agreeable to the foregoing Adjournment, provided, & Called upon the Com^{tee} for report, appointed for the purpose of Distributing the Town, into School districts, who reported, that they had met, upon said Business, & that, it was their Opinion, to New district the Town, could not be Advantageous to the Town, and as to making alterations, in said Districts it was not thought Beneficial, as there appeared upon a Calculation to be about an Equal Number, of families, in each of said Districts.
- = Then the Town by their Vote Dissolved this Meeting.
