These are to Notify & Warn, all the Freeholders, & other Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified as is provided in the Constitution of this Commonwealth, to Vote, in the Choice of a Governor, Lt. Governor, & Senators, for the year ensuing, & all others, Qualified as the Law directs, to Vote, in Town Affairs, to Meet, at the Meeting-House, in said Town, on Monday, the 2^d Day of April Next, at 1 o'clock, afternoon, on said Day then & there

1st To Bring in their Votes, for Gov^r. Lt. Gov^r. & Senators, for the year ensuing,

2^d To Choose a Moderator & act upon the 6th 9th & 11th Arts. in the warning of March Meeting, & Refer'd to April Meeting for further Consideration

3^d To fill up Vacancies, in those Town officers, which the Law Requires should any Office appear to be vacant,

4th To see, if the Town, will discontinue the road leading from Mr. Elisha Goodnow, to Mr. Jon^s. Graves & sell said Land, Agreeable to the request, of Lt. Roand Bogle & others, Do or act, as the Town shall think proper when Met.

5th To see, if the Town, will Empower either two, of their Com^{tee}. Appointed for the purpose of Letting out the Building the School-House, in the Centre District, to transact the Business, the whole of said Com^{tee} were Empowered to transact. Do or act &c &c

6th To see, if the Town, will accept of a road, as Layd out by the Selectmen, Leading through Land of Mr. Phinchas Puffer, & Land of Capt. Jon^s. Burt, & Land of Mr. Eben^r. Phympton, till it comes into the old road, at the head of Lt. Abijah Brigham's Gulf Meadow, also to see, if the Town, will give Liberty, to those persons who own the Land, which the said road is Layd out through, should have the Benefit of the old Road, in Compensation, for the New one, Do or act &c &c
