At a Legal Town Meeting, held in Sudbury on Monday, the 2^d Day of April 1798, provided, to the Business of Said Day, & Brought in their Votes, for the choice of a Gov^r. Lt. Gov^r. and Senators, for the Year ensuing, as follows,

6th Article, in the Warning of March Meeting, as contained
in this 2^d Article accepted, the Settlement of the Select-
men, with the Town Treas^r. & ordered the same, to be
Recorded,

would postpone, the further acting upon this Article, for one
Hour, & it pass'd in the Negative.

— The Qu^{est}ⁿ was again put, to see, if the Town would choose
a Com^{tee} for the purpose of Letting out the Building the
School-House, in the North East District, & it pass'd in the
Negative,

— It was then Voted, to put off the further acting upon this
Article, to some future Day.
