5th The Town, by their Vote, Empower'd, either two of their Com^{tee} chosen for the purposes Express'd in this Article to transact the Business, the whole of said Com^{tee} were Empower'd to transact, —

6th Article put over to April Meeting, for further Consideration —

3^d Then the Town took up the 3^d Article again & made choice of M^r. Josiah Richardson, for Constable, —
who has since been sworn to the faithful Discharge of his Office by the Clerk of said Town.
