is Possessed of Belonging to said Town, in order to make
their Assessments more Equitable, for the future, Agree-
ably to the Request of M^r. Joseph Dakin Do or act, &c

5th To see, if the Town, will take any Measures for erect-
ing School House, in the North East District, in said
Town, Do or act &c &c

6th To see, if the Town, will give any Encouragement
for Destroying of Crows, for any other Mischievous birds
that Pull up the young Plants of Corn, Do or act, &c

7th To see, if the Town, will take any Measures, for repairing or
Rebuilding the Bridge, which stands upon New River, then
near M^r. Benjamin Smith, Do or act &c &c

8th To see, if the Town, will take any Measures for erecting
a Newfangled House, for the accommodation of the School
House, in the Centre district in said Town, Do or act &c

9th To see, if the Town, will take Measures, for providing a
Carriage, for the Towns use, suitable for the convey-
ance of Corps to the Burying yard, Agreeable to the
Petition of Capt. Sam^l. Knight & Others Do or act, &c
