Warning Accepted.

At a Legal Town Meeting, held in Sudbury on Monday
the 7th Day of May 1798, Proceeded to the Consideration of
the 1st Article — and the Question was put, to see if the
Town, would send a Representative to the General Court, the
year ensuing, & it Passed in the Affirmative. — and
Col^d. Jonathon Rice a Freeholder, & Resident, in said Town,
was Chosen, to serve for & Represent said Town, in Gene-
ral Court, ^{for} the year ensuing —

— Having the Number, of — 44. Votes. —

2^d Article, Made Choice of Col^d. Jonathon Rice, for their
Moderator for this Meeting. — 6th Article, in the Warn-
ing of April Meeting, as Contained in this 2^d. Article
Passed over for the present, —

3^d Appointed Mr. William Hunt Jun^r. as a Committee
man for the purpose of disposing of the Brick Mentioned
in this Article as to him shall appear Most for the In-
terest of the Town, —

4th Article Passed in the Negative —

5th The Question was put, to see if the Town, would Postpone
the Erecting a school House in the North-East district in
said Town, for the present, & it passed in the Affirmative

6th It was then Voted, to Give a Bounty, of one Shilling, & six
pence p^r. Head, for Every old Crow, & Nine pence p^r. head, for
Every young one, that shall be killed within the Limits of
said Town by any Person, or Persons, Belonging to said Town, be-
tween this & the 10th Day of July Next — also appointed

the Selectmen as a Committee to take in ^{p^r}. Brown heads
& to Make out Certificates, to those persons, who shall Destroy
said Crows, of the Number, Each Person has presented. —

7th The Question was asked, to see if the Town, would appoint
a Committee, for the purpose, ^{helping} of Repairing, or Rebuilding the
Bridge Mentioned in this Article, — Provided, How People
will Assist in the Burings, and it passed in the Affirma-
tive — also Voted, that said Com^{tee} should consist, of one

Person, & Mr. Asahel Balcorn, was appointed for the above
purpose. — The Questⁿ was then put, to see if the Town
would, add any more, to said Com^{tee} & it passed in Negative
