At a Legal Town Meeting, held in Sudbury on Monday the 22^d Day of October 1798, Proceeded to the Business of said Day, & Made choice of Col^d. Jor^d. Rice for their Moderator, &

2^d Article, Granted the sum of \$ 246. 66. 7 as a salary \$ 6. M.
To the Rev^d. M^r. Biglow, for the year ensuing 246. 66. 7

3^d - Granted the sum of \$ 200 for the support of a Grammar School, the year ensuing to be equally Divided Between the five School Districts 200.

4th - Granted the sum of \$ 150, for the support of a Reading & Writing School, to be equally divided Between the five School Districts 150.

Also Granted the sum of \$ 40 for the purpose of supplying the five School Districts with wood the year ensuing to be equally Divided Between said Districts 40.

Discounted To Constable Isaac Puffer, for John Bowen Taxes for the year 1797. \$ 2. 55. -

Granted the sum of \$ 34. to enable the Treas^r. to complete a Payment, to Josiah Bernis of the sum of \$ 61. 79. for his putting in Twelve New Pilaster Stones containing 61 feet, 3 q^r to Inches & 6/10th foot. 34.

5th Article put over to the Adjournment of this Meeting

6th Article, Granted to pay their Treasurer the Present year 10.

To pay their Assessor the present year 10.

7th Vote, to Choose two Persons as Agents to appear in behalf of the Town, for the purposes Express in this Article, & Capt^t. Levi Hodder, & Capt^t. Joseph Goodnow, were Appointed, & Empowered, to act either in a corporate, or separate capacity, as circumstances shall Require Necessary.
