- These are to Notify, & Warn, all the Freeholders, & Other, Inhabitants, of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified as the Law directs, to Vote in the choice of a representative, & all others Qualified as the Law directs, to Vote in Town affairs to Meet at the Meeting-House, in said Town, on Monday the 5th Day of November Next at 1 o'clock, afternoon, on said day, then & there
- 1st To Give in their Votes, to the Selectmen, for a Federal Representative - Agreeable to an act of the General Court, passed June 26th 1794.
 - 2^d To Choose a Moderator
 - 3^d To see, if the Town, will appoint a Man, to take care of, & sweep the Meeting-House, Ring the Bells & dig graves, as Occasion may be the Year ensuing
 - 4th To see, if the Town, will take some suitable Measures, for dividing the Town a New, into School districts, Do, or act, as the Town shall think best when Mett.
 - 5th To see, if the Town, will agreeable to the Request of M^r. Isaac Puffer, grant him the privilege, of his School Money, & annex him to the School-House, Near acton line Do, or act, &c.
 - 6th To see, if the Town, will New Settle their part of the stone wall upon the South side & west End of the Burrying yard, in said Town, Do, or act, &c. &c.
 - 7th To see, if the Town, will take some suitable Measures, for Disposing of the old School-House, in the untro district in said Town, Do or act, &c. &c.
 - 8th To see, if the Town, will take any Measures, for providing, a Blank Book, for the purpose of Recording Deeds, of the Sale of Town in the Meeting-House, - Do or act, &c. &c.
 - 9th To see, if the Town, will appoint an agent, or agents, to appear in behalf of said Town, at the Dwelling House, of Abi-
